

A report on
Effects of Tauktae cyclone in coastal areas of Dakshina Kannada and Udupi
districts of Karnataka

As Cyclone Tauktae hurtled on the coastal belt and Maland districts of Kerala, Karnataka and Goa, Gale-force winds, heavy rainfall and high tidal waves, washing out hundreds of houses, damaging roofs and walls, washing out their house hold belongings, petty shops , breaking electricity poles, damaging transformers and uprooting trees and forcing evacuation. There has been coastal erosion due to rough seas along the coast, roads along the shore have been damaged, The rainfall was accompanied by gale winds speed reaching 70 to 80 km/hour, gusting at times up to 90 km/per along and off [Karnataka Kerala and Goa](#) coast.

It created havoc in the lives and livelihoods of the of the people they don't have access to nutritious food and clothes It pushed elderly, sick and children, women to the clutches of Corona Virus, as the cyclone washed out the COVID appropriate behavior. The effect of rains and winds also effected the health of the individuals creating confusion about the symptoms of flue or corona fever. It's also reported four deaths due to cyclone in different parts of Karnataka. [Karnataka](#) State Disaster Management Authority officials have warned not to step out till 18th of May 2021, thus making life more complex, as some of them have left have left nothing behind. Some of them have to build their shelters from the scratch.

According to a situation report by Sunday morning, 73 villages, 17 taluks in seven districts of Dakshina Kannada, Udupi (28 villages), Uttara Kannada, Kodagu, Shivamogga, Chikkamagaluru and Hassan have been affected by the [cyclone](#) so far.

Among the four deaths reported so far one each are from Uttara Kannada, Udupi, Chikkamagaluru and Shivamogga, Kodagu.

While one fisherman who went to tie his boat died in Uttara Kannada as he got hit by another boat, a person died in Udupi due to electricity mishap, they said, adding

that one death each were reported in Chikkamagaluru and Shivamogga due house collapse and lightning respectively.

A total of 318 people have been evacuated so far, as per the situation report, and 298 people are currently taking shelter in the 11 relief camps that have been opened.

Damages to a total of 112 houses, 139 poles, 22 transformers, 4 ha of horticulture crops have been reported so far, it added.

This is a very crucial time for them to maintain themselves cause of the Corona-Covid effect that means, they don't have the works, income which they can raise. In this condition, by overseeing we prefer to provide the following to the victims of this Cyclone as an immediate provisions:-

- Ration (Groceries for the daily Food),
- Nutritious food for Children,
- Plastic Tarpals,
- Clothes
- Bedsheets,
- Matress,
- Utencils,
- Medication Support if required,

As per your intimation we have taken a snap shot of the ground reality and compiled this document. We are yet to collect the detailed report from these people for mapping actual damages and requirement.

We are looking forward your interest and mode of help you want to render. We request you to call for an online meet to share your concept of support. We ensure all the support from our side and willingness to take the leadership to reach out the affected people in this coastal including Kasaragod region.
